DESCRIPTION

Organized with a workshopping format, this course equips students to leverage computer-aided biblical study (software and resources) for critical study of the Bible in service of their study, teaching, and preaching.

ASSESSMENT

- Students are responsible for participating in and taking turns leading the workshop, sharing aspects of the resources to colleagues.
- Each student will create a summary of a small-ish research project on a biblical text.
- Students will have a final skill exam where they demonstrate proficiency with a self-selected portion of core skills covered throughout the course.
